

International Student Cell

Standard operating procedure

- Cell refers to the updated NMC guidelines for Admission of International Students.
- All correspondence related to students admission should be addressed to the student section in main administrative office of this institution.
- Students holding passports issued by foreign countries including person of Indian origin (PIO) who have acquired citizenship of foreign countries can apply for admission.
- Non-resident Indian students who have passed the qualifying examinations (12th standard/ NEET) from schools or colleges situated in foreign countries and Students of Indian citizens whose immediate family members like parents, grandparents or siblings are NRI also can apply for admission in this institute through NRI quota.
- Student admitted under this category cannot be given change of status during the study period if the status of the sponsor is changed.
- Cell will conduct periodic meetings to cater to student's grievances.
- Cell will help to integrate all the International students into the college premises and activities without any obstacles.
- Cell will provide the Students with information about the local customs, language and civic facilities.
- Admission of all the international students will be done through CAP rounds conducted as per the guidelines from admission regulating authority Govt. of Maharashtra.



Eligibility criteria:

- A candidate should have completed the requisite criteria of age as specified in the admission brochure published time to time by admission regulating authority, Govt. of Maharashtra.
- 2. Candidates seeking admissions to medical program must have studied the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in Grades 11and 12.
- 3. Under this category only students who have studied and passed the qualifying examination from a school located in a foreign country shall be considered. This will include the student studying in a school and/or college situated in a foreign country, even if the concerned school / college is affiliated to any board of secondary education or a University in India.
- 4. In case of any school that follows the American system of education, the candidate must have studied physics, Chemistry and biology at "Advanced Placement" level and must have minimum C grade in these subjects.
- 5. The candidate should get equivalence certificate from the association of Indian University (AIU), New Delhi.

Mode of Contact
