



Proposal: Late Smt. Jasumati Pravinchandra Mavani Scholarship

Purpose:

To provide financial assistance to poor and needy girl students pursuing MBBS, in honor of Late Smt. Jasumati Pravinchandra Mavani.

1. Formation of the Scholarship Committee

Roles and Responsibilities:

- **Chairperson:** Oversee the committee's activities and ensure the scholarship's objectives are met.
- **Secretary:** Handle all documentation, communications, and meeting arrangements.
- **Treasurer:** Manage the scholarship fund, track expenses, and prepare financial reports.
- **Members:** Assist in various tasks, including application review, fund-raising, and outreach.



2. Scholarship Details:

Name: **Late Smt. Jasumati Pravinchandra Mavani Scholarship**

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a female student.
- Must be enrolled in an MBBS program.
- Must come from a financially disadvantaged background, with family income from all sources not more than Rs. 5,00,000/-
- Must have a consistent academic record.

Application Process:

Students must submit an application form along with required documents such as proof of financial status, academic records, and a personal statement.

The Scholarship Committee will review applications and shortlist candidates based on the eligibility criteria.

Selection Process:

Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by the committee.

Final selection will be based on the candidate's financial need, academic performance, and personal interview.

Scholarship Benefits:

Financial assistance for books, food, accommodation and other educational expenses, for four to five female students for every financial year starting from 2025-26.



3. Funding and Fundraising

Initial Fund: The scholarship will be funded through an initial endowment of **2,50,000/-** From Dr. Gaurang Mavani, an alumnus of 1991 batch of MIMSR Medical College, Latur Presently working at Indiana Internal Medicine Consultants, 701 East County Line Rd, Ste. 101, Greenwood, IN - 46143 (USA) and the Mavani family.

4. Monitoring and Evaluation

The Scholarship Committee will monitor the progress of the scholarship recipients through regular updates and meetings. An annual report will be prepared to evaluate the impact of the scholarship and suggest improvements if needed.

5. Procedure

- **When to apply?**
 - In the month of January of every year.
- **Whom to apply?**
 - Secretary
- **Documents to be submitted**
 - Both parents – income certificate for last financial year (ITR or certificate from tehsil office)
 - Application
 - Details of scholarship received from other sources
